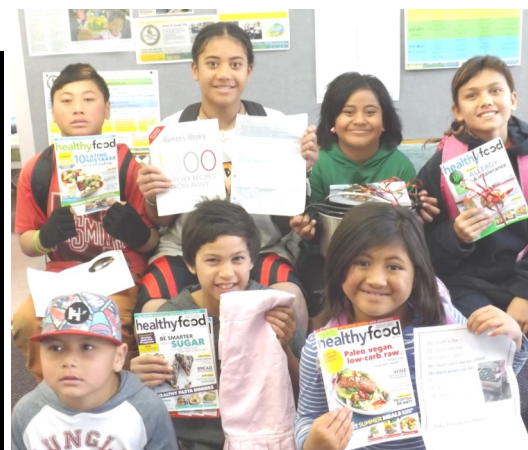


My calf's name is Lisa.

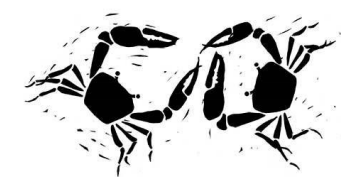

## A CRAB

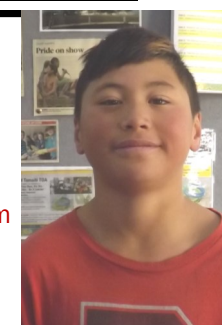

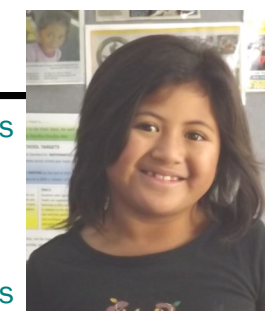

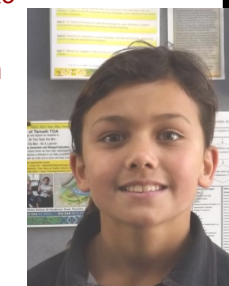
